

Active Kids Rebate Q&A

Carlile Swimming – Learn to Swim Schools

WHAT IS THE ACTIVE KIDS REBATE?

The NSW Government has implemented an Active Kids program to encourage kids to participate in sports and fitness activities, including swimming lessons.

A \$100 voucher will be provided to parents/guardians of school aged children to help cover the costs of these activities.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO CLAIM THE VOUCHER?

Every child (4.5 - 18 years' old) enrolled in school from Kindergarten to Year 12 is eligible for an Active Kids voucher.

The rebate is not means tested and one voucher will be available for every child in the family annually over the next four years.

CAN I USE THE VOUCHER TOWARDS LESSONS WITH CARLILE SWIMMING?

As a swim school we can register as a provider on 1 March, when the process opens for businesses. We anticipate that we will be able to process vouchers from late March or early April, pending approval by Service NSW. We will provide further updates via our customer service desk and our Facebook page.

Our Carlile Swimming competitive clubs fall under the sporting clubs/ associations category with Service NSW. As such, they are able to process vouchers at present. If you require further information, please contact your Carlile Swimming Club representative.

Individual items (such as sports equipment, accessories, etc.) used as part of participating in the activity cannot be purchased with the voucher.

HOW LONG ARE VOUCHERS VALID?

Year 1 will commence from 31 January and expire on 31 December 2018. Vouchers are valid for redemption during this period.

2019 vouchers and beyond commence from 1 January each year and expire on 31 December.

HOW DO YOU APPLY FOR A VOUCHER?

Parents/guardians need to visit www.service.nsw.gov.au and create an account or login.

From 31 January, you will be able to complete an Active Kids application through your MyServiceNSW account. You will receive a voucher with a unique ID number for each child you register.

If you plan to use this voucher with Carlile Swimming, please note that vouchers are only available for redemption once and cannot be split across multiple providers.
